

Post Secondary Education Award

Post Secondary Education Award - Educational Services (Post-Secondary Education) Award 2010. This Fair Work Commission consolidated modern award incorporates all amendments up to and including 21 November 2018 (PR701683,PR701478). Clause(s) affected by the most recent variation(s): The Post-Secondary Education Scheme helps parents save for their children's post-secondary education by maintaining a Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA) for each eligible child. This is part of the Government's efforts to encourage every Singaporean to complete his post-secondary education. Established on 1 April 1992, Institute of Technical Education (ITE) took over the role and functions of the Vocational & Industrial Training Board (VITB). Since its formation in 1992, ITE has focused its effort on establishing the institute as a post-secondary technical institution of excellence. The award may be used to pay educational expenses at eligible post-secondary institutions, including many technical schools and G.I. Bill approved programs, or to repay qualified students loans. The dollar amount of the education award is equal to the maximum amount of the U.S. Department of Education Pell Grant and may change year to year.
